

REQUIREMENTS FOR A SCIENTIFIC REVIEW OR REPORT AND EDITING RULES

In each issue of "Studies of Theological Sciences" we publish reviews of scientific books, and reports or discussions on events or scientific bodies on theology, philosophy, canon law and related fields relevant for reflection theological.

The scientific review should concern a book published not earlier than three years before the year in which a given issue of the magazine is published, e.g. for issue 15 (2020) the cut-off date is a review of a scientific monograph, which was published not earlier than in 2017.

The report may relate to a conference, symposium or other notable a scientific event or activity of a scientific body, relevant to the conduct of of theological research. The report should generally refer to current events, which took place at the latest in the year preceding the year of publication of the magazine's issue.

The exception is made for reports on the activities of scientific bodies and research centres theological or theological training, which may include a longer period. Volume the scientific review/report/speak should average 6-8.000 characters (with spaces), but should not exceed 10.000 characters (with spaces). W In exceptional cases, the editors of the "Study of Theological Sciences" may accept for the publication of a report exceeding this limit, especially if it relates to activities Committee of Theological Sciences of the Polish Academy of Sciences.

The text of the review or report should be saved in OpenOffice, Microsoft Word or RTF. Margins should be 2.5 cm. Throughout the text, please use Times New Roman 12 pt, line 1.

In exceptional cases, reviews/reports may be accompanied by footnotes formatted according to the rules adopted in the Studies of Theological Sciences (see **PRINCIPLES OF EDITING FOOTNOTES**).

In the header of the scientific review/report/say, the name should be placed on the left-hand side and the name of the reviewer. Then it should be stated:

- the publication's review (author's name, title - italics, place editions: publication and year of publication, number of pages) or
- the name of the event (symposium, conference), place and date.

The reviews and report are not subject to a review procedure. The decision to publish them or the editorial committee of "Studies of Theological Sciences" shall reject.
