

RULES FOR WRITING BIBLIOGRAPHY

Any scientific article (not including a scientific review, report or discussion) should be accompanied by a list of the bibliography used by the author. The list of bibliographies should not be integrated into the text, but sent with others metadata during the submission of an article by the CzasKUL Magazine Platform:

In the process of editing the bibliography, the rules for the editing of prescriptions are generally applicable, with what:

- each entry starts with the surname and initials of the first name (if known), the name the body publishing the text or title concerned (where neither the author nor the body are not known).
- In the case of articles in journals and multi-written works, it is necessary to specify give the start and end pages of the text and not just mark the place to which the author is referred refers (as in the footnotes)
- If available, a URL for bibliographic items should be provided.
